Slater Technology Funds invests in IlluminOss Medical

PROVIDENCE, R.I. -- The Slater Technology Fund, a state-backed economic development fund that invests in growing technology companies, announced Thursday a \$500,000 investment in medical device company IlluminOss Medical. The investment is part of a \$28 million round of financing.

IlluminOss, based in East Providence, is developing minimally invasive implants for the stabilization and treatment of bone fractures. The company was founded in 2007 by Bob Rabiner in collaboration with orthopedic surgeons from Lifespan/Rhode Island Hospital.
